Virtue is the moral courage to do right, so that we care for and protect others near us. Virtue does what is necessary to respond to threats.

James Madison wrote, "Is there no virtue among us? If there be not, we are in a wretched situation. No theoretical checks – no form of government – can render us secure." George Washington stated, "Virtue and morality is a necessary spring of [people's] government."

The Bill of Rights provides a blueprint for virtue, but it only works if we use it. The Founders told us the tools needed to defend American liberty. One example is the Second Amendment, which says that a "militia" is necessary. In those days, militia meant all men in the community, who would be trained to care for and protect each other. The design for America involves citizens taking local action.

Thomas Jefferson continued this theme when he envisioned what we call "Jefferson's Hundreds." He wrote that if tyranny threatened, the entire country should divide ourselves into self-sufficient communities of one hundred households each. He thought these areas would be like lighthouses in the storm where citizens could read and publish truth, support each other in small farming, and build relationships to overcome a threat together.

Impending Threats and How to Respond

Civil Unrest and Violence: The proliferation of mob activity fomented by terrorists, political instigators, or paid criminals

Response: Homes and businesses should be equipped with weapons and ammunition, and individuals should be organized in their communities in advance with a response plan. A community could consider designating a defensible safe-house for citizens.

Power Grid Failure: A short- or long-term electric outage, for example due to an EMP strike

Response: Families and local communities will not be able to depend on outside assistance. The infrastructure to live and work "off the grid," including food, must be put in place in advance.



National Debt Crisis: A major economic recession or meltdown, with a possible failure of the U.S. dollar

Response: Churches, local charities, neighborhood groups, and families should be prepared to pick up the burden of many services currently provided by government agencies.

Federal Overreach: Unconstitutional actions that impose on key American liberties

Response: The Federal government was formed by the states and is subject to them. Local and state officials must stand up, refuse to comply, and protect citizens if a Federal body violates the law.
